The Bay County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session in its office in the Courthouse at 9:00 o'clock A. M., with all members present.

The chairman called the meeting to order and the following business was transacted.

On motion by commissioner Buchanan, seconded by commissioner Pitts, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 390, Florida Statutes 1941, in order to create a Mosquito Control District, a petition signed by not less than fifteen per cent (15%) of the resident free-holders of voting Precinct Nos. 10 and 11 who are registered voters was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida, on August 11, 1952, and

WHEREAS, After consideration of the petition by the Board of County Commissioners, it has been determined that said Mosquito Control District is for the benefit of public health, comfort and welfare of the inhabitants thereof, Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED By the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida, that October 14, 1952, be and the same is hereby designated as the day for the holding of a Special Election for the purpose of voting upon whether or not there shall be created a Mosquito Control District in Bay County, Florida, to be known as "Gulf Mosquito Control District" and for the purpose of electing a Board of Commissioners for said district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That in compliance with said Section, a notice of Special election for such purpose be published one each week during four (4) consecutive weeks in Bay County, Florida.

On motion by commissioner Buchanan, seconded by commissioner Pitts and carried, the E. & I. Roll for 1951 Intangible taxes, presented by A. O. Appelberg, Bay County Tax Collector was approved by the Board and Ordered Filed.

On motion by commissioner Buchanan, seconded by commissioner Pitts and carried, the plat of Crestview Heights, presented by Mr. Sam B. Kern, was approved by the Board.

On motion by commissioner Miller, seconded by commissioner Hill and carried by a unanimous affirmative vote, the Board agreed to deed the following described property owned by Bay County to Ernest N. Brown and wife, Laura Allan Brown:

Beginning at the SE corner of Blk. 57, Callaway Plat, which is located in Section 17/18, Township 4 South, Range 13 West, thence S. 380 ft. more or less to Bayou, thence Northerly and Westerly to the East side of Bethel Avenue; thence North along East side of Avenue to the SW corner of said Block 57; thence East to point of beginning. Comprising two and one half acres more or less,

and in exchange for the above described property, the board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida, hereby agrees to accept a deed from C. O. Allan and wife, Louvina Allan to the following described property:

Beginning at a point which is 800 ft. South of the NW corner of Section 3, Township 5 South, Range 12 West, thence East 330 ft.; South 660 ft.; thence West 330 ft.; thence North along West Section line 660 ft. to pt. of beg. Located in the 1/2 of NW 1/4 of U. 3. Lot #3, Section 3, Township 5 South, Range 12 West.

On motion by commissioner Miller, seconded by commissioner Hill, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners on October 13, 1952, adopted a resolution authorizing and directing the attorney for the Board to institute the necessary eminent domain proceeding to condemn a parcel of land hereinafter described for a county purpose to construct a drainage ditch to drain water from a county road adjacent to the described property, and

WHEREAS, Eminent domain proceedings were instituted pursuant to the resolution, and a Declaration of Taking was made directed to J. M. Peacock taking the following described property, to-wit:

A tract of land 50 feet wide, being described as that land that falls within 25 feet of either side of the following described centerline of county drainage ditch; Begin at a point 395 feet south of the Northwest corner of Lot No. 7, Block 34, according to Plat of Highland City as on file in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Bay County, Florida; thence running Easterly a distance of 331 feet to a point on the East boundary line of said Lot 7, Block 34, Being a part of Lot No. 7, Block No. 34, according to the plat of Highland City as on file in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Bay County, Florida, containing 0.38 acre, and

WHEREAS, Since the institution of said proceeding, the said J. M. Peacock has agreed to convey to Bay County the described property at and for the sum of \$50.00 and upon advice of counsel, it is deemed advisable to pay said sum for said land, the same being a reasonable price therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners acquire the above described property from J. W. Peacock for the purposes aforesaid and that the Clerk of the Circuit Court be, and he is hereby authorized to issue a county warrant in the sum of \$50.00 against the Road Fund to pay for the same.

Pursuant to Special Primary Election held on October 14th, 1952, to determine whether or not a mosquito control district shall be created in the Beach area of Bay County, the canvassing Board met to canvass the returns of the election and as a result thereof issued the following certificate showing the results of the election on this question:

We, the undersigned Joseph W. Bailey, County Judge, J. B. Mashburn, Supervisor of Registration, and J. H. Davis of the Board of County Commissioners of said County, constituting the Board of County Canvassers, in and for said county, do hereby certify that we met at the office of the Supervisor of Registration aforesaid, on the 16th day of October, A. D., 1952, and proceeded publicly to canvass the votes given for the question and persons hereinafter specified in the special election held in said County on the 14th day of October, A. D., 1952, as shown by the returns on file in the office of such Judge and Supervisor of Registration respectively, and we do hereby certify that:

SHALL GULF MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT, BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, BE CREATED?, upon which question the whole number of votes cast was 142, of which number 137 voted YES; and 5 voted NO.

FOR COMMISSIONERS OF GULF MOSQUITO CONTROL DISTRICT, BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, the following votes were cast: Grier C. Darnhart received 132 votes; John Raymond Arnold received 130 votes; Isale Kraselaky received 120 votes; T. A. Tucker received 5 votes; Joe Hill received 2 votes; Hugh N. Parsons received 2 votes; John Webb received 1 vote.
